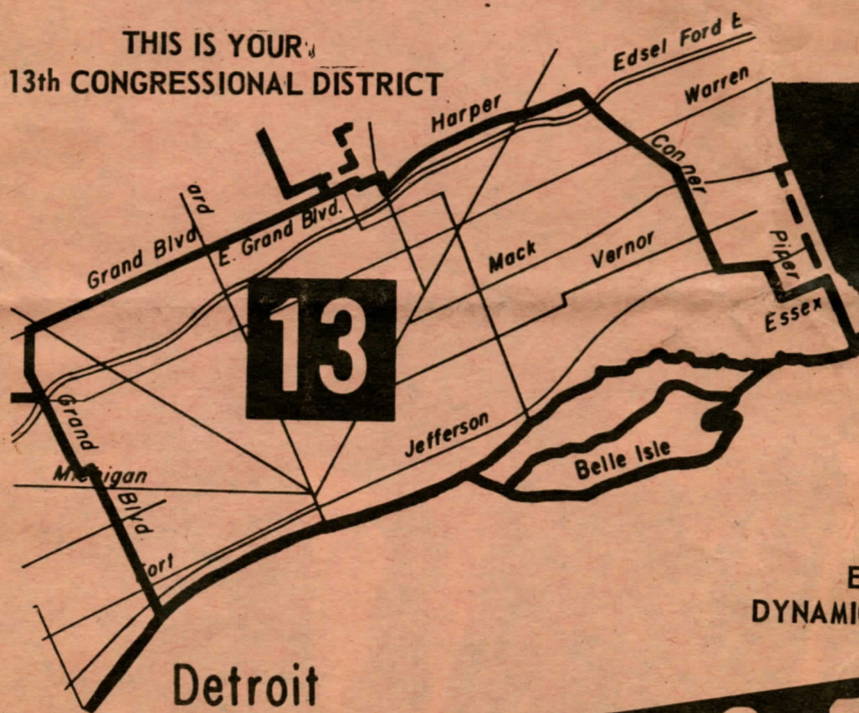

As optimism that the Demonstration Cities bill will be adopted grows in Washington, Detroit is readying a plan for near complete rebuilding of the Inner City.

The plan would concentrate federal funds on a 20 year redevelopment of the area within the Grand Boulevard loop as a city - within - a - city of 300,000 people.

It would include preservation of structurally sound or historically significant buildings as well as massive urban renewal.

Current estimate of cost, only guesswork at this point, is \$780 million, with the city paying \$48 million and the federal government providing the rest.

City Controller Richard Strichartz returned from Washington yesterday, after conferring with officials of the Housing and Urban Development Department (HUD) on what has been called the most ambitious model city program in the nation.

Part of the planning would include changes in the urban renewal law enabling the city to retain title to streets and alleys in renewal areas, which would, in effect, give the city 128 acres of free land for parks in every square mile.

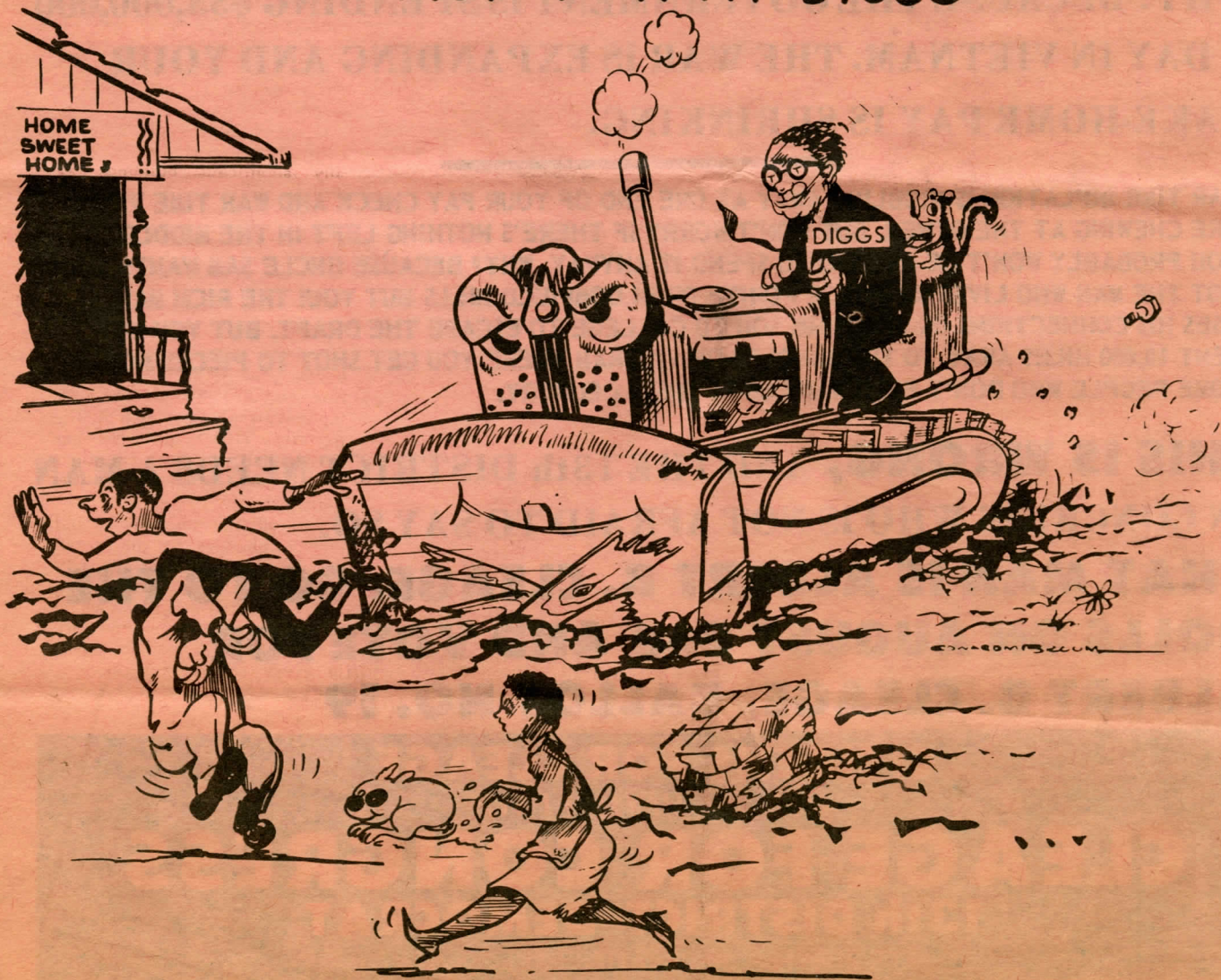

Greatest Scholars, Scientists Condemn U.S. War Role

NEW YORK — An overwhelming number of American men and women from all walks of professional and academic life have drafted and signed a condemnation of the Johnson Administration's policy of brutal bombings and "search-and-kill" operations through which the U.S. military has succeeded in obliterating a large segment of the Vietnamese population and countryside.

MORE THAN 6,400 persons have signed the petition, which appeared in the form of an advertisement in the *New York Times*, making it the largest such political advertisement in the history of any American daily newspaper.

The sponsors of the appeal have pointed out that the slaughter of thousands of Vietnamese and American troops, the devastation of Vietnamese homes and sources of livelihood by U.S. troops are based on "false premises" and they called for "an immediate cease fire" in order to "negotiate with the National Liberation Front and all other interested parties for a peaceful settlement" of the conflict.

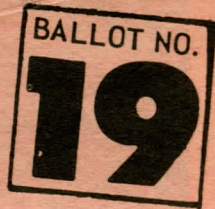
The sponsoring groups of the petition are the Ad Hoc Universities Committee for the Statement on Viet Nam and the Committee of the Professions. The former group was set up a month ago, especially to rally advertising support, by Prof. Harry Lustig, chairman of the department of physics, City College of New York, and Martin Davis, professor of mathematics at New York University.

THE SECOND sponsoring group, headed by Dr. Oscar Sachs, a New York psychiatrist, and Miss Ruth Lassoff, consists of thousands of

America's creative artists and professional entertainers.

Noted signers of the petition include Francis Grover Cleveland, 62-year-old son of the late President, and two

Nobel prize winners — Polycarp Kusch, professor of physics at Columbia University, and Albert Szent-Gyorgyi, of the Marine Biology Laboratories, Woods Hole, Mass.

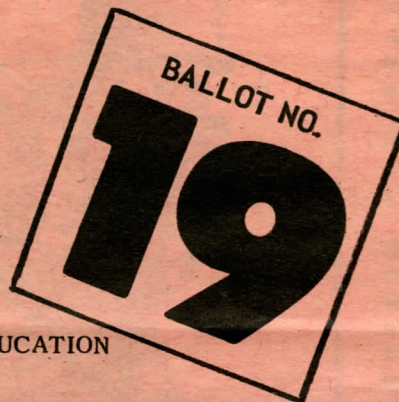
