Disenchanted with both major political parties, which, he said, have betrayed the cause of justice, civil rights leader Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. said yesterday that he "tends to favor" formation of an all-Negro political party.

Dr. King said at a press con-

ference that he tends to favor a group similar to the Freedom Now party proposed here last week.

"Democrats have capitulated to the undemocratic ideals of southern Dixiecrats, and Republicans too often accept the blatant hypocrisy of right-wing Northerners," the clergyman said.

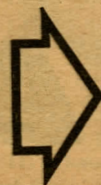
Although Dr. King said he was not too familiar with the

proposal for an all-Negro party made by the Rev. Albert B. Cleage Jr. here, he noted:

"I would tend to favor something like this if it would increase the Negro's voice in politics and his interest in participating in politics."

Mr. Cleage, pastor of the Central Congregational Church, made the proposal before 250 persons in his church in a call for "independent black action."
