

RESOLUTION PASSED BY DETROIT HOUSING COMMISSION,

BY UNANIMOUS VOTE -- JANUARY 30, 1942.

WHEREAS: The Mayor and the Common Council of the City of Detroit have officially asked the National Defense Housing Authorities to change the status of the Nevada-Genelon Defense Project from White to Negro, and

WHEREAS: This project was originally built for Negro occupancy, and

WHEREAS: The acute shortage of homes for Negro defense workers makes it imperative that they be given immediate consideration, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Detroit Housing Commission is in accord with the action taken by Mayor Jeffries, and the Common Council.
