The National Negro Labor Council has launched a national campaign for 100,000 jobs for Negro workers in skills where we have never worked before.

A chapter of the Greater Chicago Council of that organization is bringing the campaign for jobs into our community. In stores and factories we are demanding that Negro workers be hired in every skill, Negro workers, whose dollars swell the profits of these concerns.

We Negro workers with the support of white workers are demanding Fair Employment Practices Now!

#### SKILLED JOBS NOT DISHWASHING

We are fed up with "whites only" and "no colored" when applying for work. We will no longer settle for lower paid dirty jobs beneath our skills. No longer will employment agencies chain us to unemployment by selling the same job every two weeks to another Negro worker. We are going to fight especially for jobs for Negro women who are hardest hit by Jim Crow employers.

#### SUPPORT FIGHT FOR F.E.P.C.

The Negro Labor Council is sending delegations to all stores, offices, and factories with the demand they sign our model Fair Employment Practices Clause.

"In all matters of hiring, training, promotion, pay, layoff, and recall there will be no discrimination against anyone whatsoever because of color, sex, religion, political affiilation, or national origin."

Those employers who live up to this Fair Employment Practices Clause will be recognized by our emblem on their doors and windows.



While concentrating our main efforts behind this campaign for 100,000 jobs for Negro workers, we recognize the need to fight for Negro rights in every field.

#### **DEFEAT THE "STATE RIGHTERS"**

In the elections we will expose the candidates who make false promises for "civil rights." We will demand that they publicly declare themselves for FEPC legislation with enforcement provisions.

#### IN UNITY THERE IS STRENGTH

The Negro Labor Council is ready to work with any and all organizations. Our objective is not to create dual unionism but rather to work with and aid unions and other organizations in the fight for full economic, political, and social equality for the Negro people.

#### NEGRO AND WHITE UNITY IS THE KEY

We know that alone we cannot win this fight. We are counting on the support of the white workers, who as our allies, are seeing more and more that their own conditions cannot be improved so long as Negroes are chained in second class citizenship. The unity of Negro and white is the keystone, not only to the fight for FEPC, anti-lynch legislation, against the poll tax, and jim crow housing, but it is the keystone in the fight for lower prices, new housing, and world peace for all.
